The **American Tree Farm System** (ATFS) is a program built with a nationwide network of landowners, foresters, and volunteers.

We are a family forest landowner-run national organization with state chapters that certify forest landowners according to a set of strict internationally recognized standards. Those rigorous standards reflect the ATFS values of **wood**, **water**, **wildlife** and **recreation**.

The Oregon chapter of ATFS is OTFS, or **Oregon Tree Farm System**. Our mission is: Empowering private landowners to manage their forests sustainably. At the state and local levels, the ATFS program is implemented by volunteer committees and partners. Nationwide, there are about 70,000 landowners, affectionately known as "Tree Farmers," about 1,100 live in Oregon.



The objectives of landowners in the program are quite diverse, ranging from maintaining wildlife habitat and participating in recreational activities to growing trees to produce wood products. They all share a deep connection to their land and want to keep it in good health and manage it sustainably.
