SEED SELECTION

Achillea millefolium (Yarrow)

Clarkia amoena var. *lindleyi* (Farewell to Spring)

Gilia capitate (Blue Field Gilia)

Lupinus Polycarpus (Lupine Small Flower)

Lupinus Polyphyllus (Lupine Large Leaf)

30lbs of each variety

3 properties - each get 50lb mix

L&H Seeds
Connell, WA
lhseeds.com

\$3,100 investment per property





6-10oz per burned pile

6oz = 20x20 burned pile

8oz = 30x30 burned pile

10oz = 40x40 burned pile

50lb mix average 100-125 burned piles
(Roughly \$2.15 per oz)



Where...

Select burned piles directly adjacent to roads

Easy to monitor and maintain
The seed will spread itself


